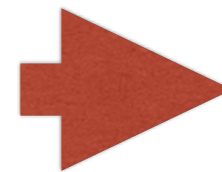

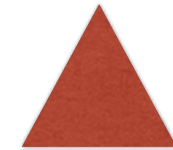

How does God Change our hearts?

1. Convincing us that it is time to Abort the “conceived desire”.

Heb 3:14-15

For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, while it is said: “Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not ***harden*** your hearts as in the rebellion.”

How does God Change our hearts?

2. Providing an avenue of Escape.

1 Corinthians 10:13

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, **but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*.**

How does God Change our hearts?

3. Giving Us the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 5: 15-21

17 Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is. 18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but **be filled with the Spirit**, 19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,
